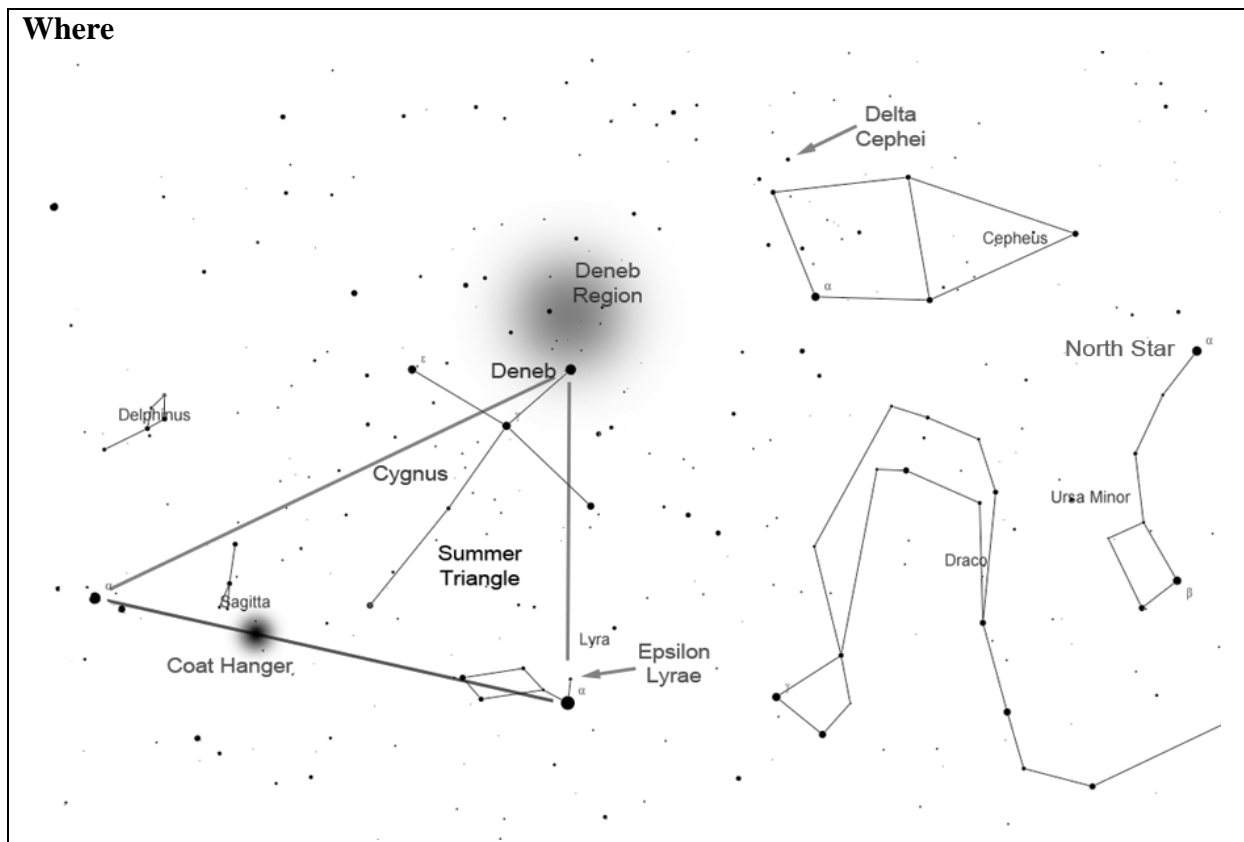

Object Information

Object	Type	Details
Epsilon Lyrae	Multiple star	Easily split; ~100 solar systems would fit between the two stars; ~162 light years distant; each star in the pair is itself a binary!
Delta Cephei	Cepheid variable star	Varies its brightness over a period of about 5.37 days; pulsating variable star; 1 st Cepheid-type variable star ever discovered; Cepheids are used to determine some distances in the Milky Way and nearby galaxies
Deneb Region	Pretty star field	Just a very pretty binocular view!
The Coat Hanger	Asterism	10 unrelated stars in a small group that looks like a coat hanger
