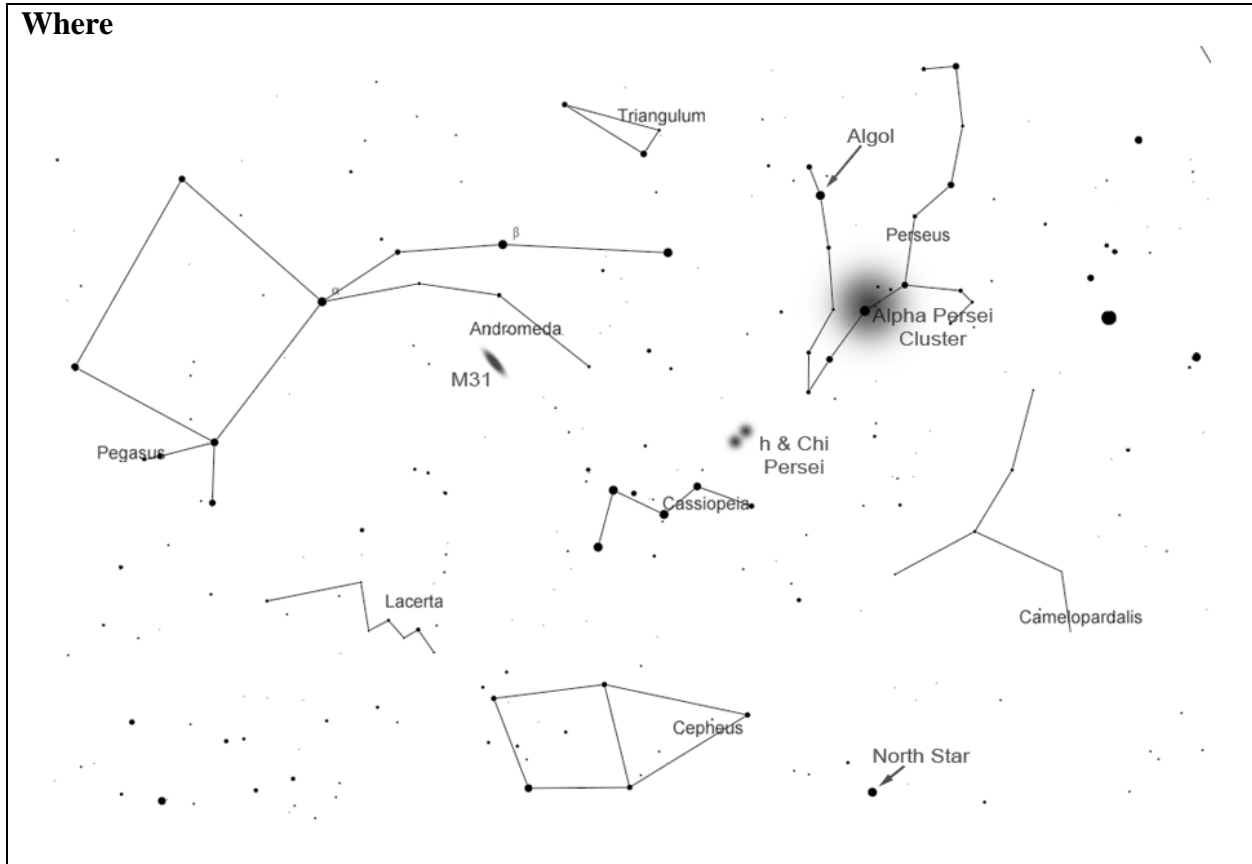

Object Information

Object	Type	Details
M31	Spiral galaxy	Unaided eye visibility; distance ~2.5 million LY; closest spiral galaxy to the Milky Way; looks like a “faint fuzzy”
h & Chi Persei	Double open star cluster; unaided eye visibility	2 neighboring clusters ~7500 light years distant; many faint stars
Alpha Persei Cluster	Open star cluster	About a dozen stars near Alpha Persei; ~570 light years distant; fills a binocular view; very pretty!
Algol	Eclipsing variable star	Unaided eye visibility; 2 stars orbiting each other edge-on to us, but looks like one star; brightness drops for about 10 hours every 2.86 days
